United by a shared love of performing bluesy, soulful music in the most intimate and acoustic of settings, Blicher Hemmer Gadd's hard-swinging 4th album - It will be Alright - both recreates the excitement and energy of the late-night sets they've performed around the world together but also holds to special tracks that was recorded in Michaels intimate garden-studio in Copenhagen during lockdown.

Formed after a chance encounter more than 10 years ago, drum legend Steve Gadd, Danish Grammy-winning saxophonist Michael Blicher and hammond-wizard Dan Hemmer continue with this joyful project, which has flourished despite the 3,000+ miles, 40+ years and 3 busy touring schedules which separate them.

After decades performing stadiums with the likes of Eric Clapton, James Taylor and Steely Dan, Gadd relishes the opportunity to rediscover the sound and feel of playing almost acoustically. "This is honest Music" he says. "No one plays like this anymore."

In fact, so integral is that 'live' element to the band that most of the albums tracks were recorded on tour, in front of an audience. Saxophonist Michael Blicher's lyrical compositions bring out the soul of the band, providing the perfect foundation for the dazzling interplay and and heartfelt improvisations that follow.

The vibrating drum skins, the bamboo of the saxophone reed and the tone wheels of a 50 year-old Hammond organ combine to give a collection of songs both respectful of the past and fresh for 21st Century ears.
